





Welcome to the ABC Book Club! Rules of the Club

- 1. Fifteen books <u>must</u> be read each month or 15-20 minutes of supervised reading in a night can count as one book. (For example, if it takes your child 3 nights to read a particular book or a chapter book, it will count as 3 books, as long as each of the 3 nights your child reads for a minimum of 15 20 minutes.)
- 2. The <u>student</u> must write down the <u>title</u>, <u>author (first initial and last name is fine) and type of book.</u> Only neat work will be accepted. Work written by parents will not be accepted.
- 3. ****Parents, remember to sign the book list verifying that the books have been read.
- 4. If the book list is lost, any lined paper is acceptable.
- 5. ****Please look on the book list for the <u>date</u> the lists are <u>due</u>
 back at school. It is important they be returned on time. There
 will be a monthly celebration and an award given to students who
 return their signed book list to the teacher by the due date.
- 6. An author will be featured in the classroom each month and students may or may not choose to read that author's books.
